DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This brick farmhouse, a two story, three bay structure apparently was built in two parts. The older section being the two northern bays, would appear to date from the third quarter of the 19th century. The addition is typical of the 1890-1910 period. Also present is a stone outbuilding with an exterior stone chimney topped with brick and a frame bank barn with brick graineries.




