DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This two story, five bay house is of frame construction and is sheathed with German siding. The main entrance, centrally located has a four light transom above the door with three light side lights. Nine over six pane windows are used at the first story level while six over six pane windows are at the second floor. The house would appear to date from the mid 19th century.
