BUILDING DATE: early 19th century

138 West Main Street is a north-facing, horizontally massed, symmetrical, three-and-a-half-story, six-bay, brick, freestanding, residential structure resting on a stone foundation. Set directly at the public-right-of-way, it is a large imposing structure built in the Federal or Adam style. The side-gable roof, which is sheathed with artificial roll, has four massive pairs of brick, bridged chimneys. Entrances are located at the exposed basement level in the center bay, and on the first floor that is approached by a set of stairs on the eastern edge of the building. The basement entrance is a secondary one. The main entrance, on the first floor, is of a typical Federal design. A wide, six-panel door is set in a round-arched frame, flanked by sidelights, and topped by a diamond-paned lunette. An ornate, hipped-roof, wrought-iron porch extends across the facade from the door to the eastern edge of the building (to the stairs). It is supported below by brick piers. Windows are set in wood frames, are double-hung, six-over-six sash with jackarches (those on the first level being more elaborate than those at the basement or second level). There is one addition and one outbuilding. These are noted on the 1922 Sanborn, however, the addition is indicated as only being a single story, not two stories as it is today. It is set on a large lot that has not been subdivided since the town was platted.

Based on its style and the fact that brick buildings were not common in Washington County at the very beginning of the 19th century, it is likely that this structure dates to the 1820s or

1830s. The building with the extant configuration is noted on the 1877 map of the town as being owned by H. B. Rohrback. The 1922 Sanborn notes the extant dwelling as 222 West Main and indicates a very large outbuilding at the rear of the lot. It is currently known as Pineapple Plantation.

The building is within the Western Maryland Geographic Organization, the Development Period of Rural Agrarian Intensification, and falls within the Historic Period Theme of Architecture, Landscape Architecture and Community Planning.




