108 West Main Street is a north-facing, horizontally massed, symmetrical, two-and-a-half-story, brick (common bond), five-bay, freestanding, residential structure resting on a stone foundation. There is a flat-roofed, two-story addition on the west end of the building that is flush with the facade. It is set directly at the public-right-of-way. The side-gable, standing-seam metal roof has open eaves, a box cornice, gable returns, and two large, corbelled, interior endwall chimneys. The entrance, which is located in the center bay, consists of a recessed, four-panel door topped by a slightly arched, two-pane transom. An entrance of similar design is found in the two-story addition. The floor is composed of double-hung, two-over-two, windows with jackarches and stone sills.

This house appears to date from the second quarter of the 19th century and has commemorative plaque indicating that it was standing in 1862. A building of a similar configuration is noted on the 1877 map of the town as being owned by William Roulette. It is noted on the 1922 Sanborn as 233 West Main and as part of a larger property that extended to Mechanic Street.

The building is within the Western Maryland Geographic Organization, the Development Period of Agricultural-Industrial Transition, and falls within the Historic Period Theme of Architecture, Landscape Architecture, and Community Planning.
