BUILDING DATE: early-mid 19th century

115 East Antietam Street is a south-facing, horizontally massed, symmetrical, one-and-a-half-story, five-bay, log, freestanding, structure resting on a stone foundation. The exposed logs are V-notched with stone slabs stuffed in the cracks between the logs. Set directly at the public-right-of-way, the building has received several additions, including a hipped-roof, eastlake portico over the center-bay entrance, and a shed dormer that extends across the entire facade. The side gable roof is sheathed with standing-seam metal and has a modern endwall brick chimney. The 15-light door is set in a wood frame with a transom above. Windows are all double-hung, one-over-one sash. There is a one-story wing to the rear, as well as a log outbuilding. The property has not been subdivided since the town was platted.

A building of the same configuration is noted on the 1877 map of the town as being owned by Mrs. Barley. The 1922 Sanborn notes the extant building as 311 East Antietam, but does not note the addition of the dormer. Nor does it note that the building is of log construction, perhaps indicating that the building was sheathed in weatherboarding at the time the information for the map was collected.

The building is within the Western Maryland Geographic Organization, the possible Development Period of Agricultural-Industrial Transition, and falls within the Historic Period Theme of Architecture, Landscape Architecture and Community Planning.
