111 East Antietam Street is a south-facing, vertically massed, symmetrical, two-and-a-half-story, three-bay, brick (Flemish bond), freestanding, residential structure resting on a stone foundation. Set directly at the public-right-of-way, it has a recent garage and porte-cochere addition to the east. The side-gable roof is sheathed with artificial roll, has one interior, endwall brick chimney, and overhanging eaves. The east-bay entrance consists of an interior door with paneling and a fanlight and a modern exterior storm door. Windows are set in wood frames, are two-over-two sash with shutters. There are several outbuildings to the rear of the property, including an attached stone and stucco kitchen, and a stone, shed-roof smokehouse(?).

A building of similar configuration is noted on the 1877 map of the town as being owned by Nichols. The 1922 Sanborn notes the extant dwelling as 308 East Antietam and indicates that the dwelling has a one-story frame addition attached to the main house. To this is attached a one-story stone addition, and then another one-story frame addition. A one-story, freestanding structure is shown immediately east of the stone addition and a two-story barn is indicated at the rear of the lot.

The building is within the Western Maryland Geographic Organization, the Development Period of Agricultural-Industrial Transition, and falls within the Historic Period Theme of Architecture, Landscape Architecture and Community Planning.


