105 South Mechanic Street is a west-facing, vertically massed, symmetrical, two-and-a-half-story, three-bay, frame, freestanding, residential structure. Set directly on the public-right-of-way, it rests on a stone foundation. The side-gable, asphalt shingle roof has open eaves and gable returns. The first-floor front facade is composed of the south-bay entrance; two, double-hung, two-over-two windows in the remaining bays; and a flat-roof porch that extends the length of the facade. The remaining windows are identical to the ones on the first floor, with the exception of two windows on the north facade that are paired. All windows and the door frame have crown molding. There is a one-story rear addition.

Based on the style and construction of the building, it appears to have been erected during the late 19th/early 20th century. It is not noted on the 1877 map of the town. The 1922 Sanborn notes the building as 321 South Mechanic Street.

The building is within the Western Maryland Geographic Organization, the Development Period of Industrial/Urban Dominance, and falls within the Historic Period Themes of Architecture, Landscape Architecture and Community Planning.
