~~230~~ West Main Street is a north-facing, symmetrical, two-and-a-half-story, L-shaped, two-bay, frame, freestanding, residential structure. Set directly at the public-right-of-way, the building is set on a stone foundation. It has a side-gable, standing-seam metal roof with open eaves and gable returns. There is a interior, endwall, corbelled brick chimney at the east elevation. The first-floor front facade is composed of an entrance in the west bay protected by an ornate, hipped-roof, open, eastlake porch that extends the length of the facade. Fenestration consists of double-hung, two-over-two windows with shutters and crown molding. There is a one-story rear wing and a large outbuilding.

The building appears to date from the late 19th/early 20th century. It is noted on the 1922 Sanborn as 34 West Main.. At the time, the back porch was not enclosed. The shed addition on the outbuilding is also noted as an open porch.

The building is within the Western Maryland Geographic Organization, the Development Period of Industrial/Urban Dominance, and falls within the Historic Period Theme of Architecture, Landscape Architecture, and Community Planning.
