BUILDING DATE: First half 19th century (pre-1862)

226 West Main Street is a north-facing, horizontally massed, symmetrical, one-and-a-half-story, five-bay, brick (Flemish bond), freestanding, residential structure set directly at the public-right-of-way on a stone foundation. The side gable roof is sheathed with standing-seam metal, has one interior, endwall brick chimney and one exterior, endwall cinderblock chimney. The center-bay entrance is protected by a shed-roof, open porch that runs the length of the center three bays and is supported by squared posts connected by a slat rail. The interior glazed and paneled door is protected by a modern storm door. Windows are set in wood frames, are double-hung, two-over-two sash, and have jack arches.

A commemorative plaque indicates that the building was standing in 1862. A passerby mentioned that the structure is believed to have been used as a gun shop during the Civil War. A building of the same configuration is noted on the 1877 map of the town as being owned by F. Swain. The 1922 Sanborn notes the building as a dwelling numbered as 116 West Main.

The building is within the Western Maryland Geographic Organization, the Development Period of Agricultural-Industrial Transition, and falls within the Historic Period Theme of Architecture, Landscape Architecture and Community Planning.




