BUILDING DATE: early 19th century

226 West Chapline Street is a raised, north-facing, horizontally massed, symmetrical, one-and-a-half-story, five-bay, stone, freestanding, residential structure. Set directly at the public-right-of-way, it rests on an exposed stone basement. The stone is rock-faced and randomly coursed. The side-gable roof, which is sheathed with corrugated metal, has two interior, endwall, brick chimneys; open eaves; and gable returns. The entrance, which is located in the center bay, is approached by a long set of stairs leading up to a shed-roof portico. The portico is supported by chamfered posts and defined by a slat railing. The interior door is victorian in styling with four raised panels, the top two of which are arched. Windows are set in wood frames and are modern, double-hung, six-over-six sash. Windows in the attic are casements.

The building appears to date from the early 19th century. A commemorative plaque confirms that it was standing in 1862. The 1922 Sanborn notes the extant dwelling as 111 West Chapline and indicates two frame outbuildings at the rear of the lot: a one-story shed and a two-story unidentified structure.

The building is within the Western Maryland Geographic Organization, the Development Period of Agricultural-Industrial Transition, and falls within the Historic Period Theme of Architecture, Landscape Architecture and Community Planning.
