BUILDING DATE: late 19th/early 20th century

211 West Chapline Street is a south-facing, vertically massed, asymmetrical, one-and-a-half-story, two-bay, frame, freestanding, residential structure. Set slightly back from the public-right-of-way, it has been covered with a brick veneer. Based on the depth of the window and door recesses, it is possible that this is a log structure. The front-gable, corrugated metal roof has open and overhanging eaves and a brick chimney. The first-floor front facade is composed of an entrance in the west bay; a single, double-hung, six-over-six window; and a shed awning that extends across the face of the building. The entrance is composed of a four-panel interior door and a multi-pane, frame storm door. The attic has two four-pane casement windows facing the street. The house has a shed-roof garage attached to the east elevation.

The 1877 map of the town does not note a building at this location. However, the 1922 Sanborn notes the extant building as a frame dwelling numbered 106 West Chapline.

The building is within the Western Maryland Geographic Organization, the probable Development Period of Industrial/Urban Dominance, and falls within the Historic Period Theme of Architecture, Landscape Architecture and Community Planning.


