206 South Hall Street is an east-facing, horizontally massed, symmetrical, three-bay, one-and-a-half-story, frame, freestanding, residential structure on a concrete foundation. The building is set directly at the public-right-of-way, above a stone retaining wall, and is covered with manufactured siding. The standing-seam metal, side-gable roof has one rebuilt exterior endwall brick chimney, open eaves, and a gable dormer. The center-bay entrance consists of a modern door which is protected by a gable-roof, portico. Fenestration is composed of modern, single, rectangular, double-hung, one-over-one windows. There is a shed-roof addition to the rear.

A building of similar configuration is noted on the 1877 map of the town. However, it is difficult to discern whether it is the extant structure. The building is not noted on the 1922 Sanborn as that map does not include this portion of Sharpsburg.

The building is within the Western Maryland Geographic Organization, the probable Modern Development Period, and falls within the Historic Period Theme of Architecture, Landscape Architecture, and Community Planning.
