210 East Chapline Street is a north-facing, horizontally massed, symmetrical, two-and-a-half-story, three-bay, frame, freestanding, residential structure set on a stucco-finished stone foundation. Set at the public-right-of-way, it has been extensively altered with the addition of manufactured siding. It has a side-gable, corrugated metal roof. The first-floor front facade is composed of an entrance in the center bay and two modern, double-hung, six-over-six windows in the remaining bays. Windows on the second floor match those on the first.

The building is noted on the 1922 Sanborn as 411 East Chapline. There is no building located at this site on the 1877 map.

The building is within the Western Maryland Geographic Organization, the Development Period of Industrial/Urban Dominance, and falls within the Historic Period Themes of Architecture, Landscape Architecture and Community Planning.
