This is a south-facing, horizontally massed, asymmetrical, two-and-a-half-story, five-bay, frame with brick veneer, attached, residential and commercial structure resting on a stone foundation. Set directly at the public-right-of-way, the building has received a brick veneer on its facade and manufactured siding on its side elevations. The focus of the front elevation is a two-story hexagonal bay with windows in each face. The side-gable roof is covered with standing-seam metal and has three brick chimneys. Entrances are located in the east bay, the bay immediately west of the hexagonal bay and in what is today a shop front. The two residential entrances are slightly raised and recessed and consist of craftsman style doors. They are topped by three-light transoms and a stone lintel. All windows are double-hung, one-over-one sash with flat lintels and lug sills. The storefront in the western portion of the building consists of a deeply recessed entrance flanked by showcases. A fiberglass awning covers this segment of the structure. There are two large one-story additions to the rear of the building forming a U-shaped composition.

According to a commemorative plaque on the building, the structure was standing in 1862. The front segment of the building is indicated on the 1877 map of the town as being owned by S. Show. The Banner history of Sharpsburg notes that Martin L. Burgan had a curio shop and an ice cream parlor in this building c. 1914. The 1922 Sanborn shows the entire structure as a frame building with a

brick veneer. It notes the eastern portion as a dwelling numbered 307 and the western portion as a confectionery numbered 306. Today the western portion is occupied by Bender's Tavern.

The building is within the Western Maryland Geographic Organization, the Development Period of Agricultural-Industrial Transition, and falls within the Historic Period Themes of Economics; and Architecture, Landscape Architecture and Community Planning.
