Description of Property and Eligibility Determination: *(Use continuation sheet if necessary and attach map and photo)*

No. 333-335 North Main Street is a two-and-one-half-story, three-bay-wide, hip-roofed, detached, masonry, American Foursquare dwelling with a commercial corner entrance on the northwest corner. The house has an asphalt-shingled roof, interior chimney, and 1/1 wood sash windows with stone lintels. Hip dormers are centered on the west and east slopes of the roof. There is a one-story, two-bay, hip-roofed porch with square wood posts on brick piers. A cornice extends north from the porch and wraps the northern bay and part of north elevation above the first floor. The commercial entrance is a set of double-leaf doors set onto the corner of the building. As an example of the popular American Foursquare form of domestic architecture (with a commercial/mixed use modification) in early-twentieth-century Boonsboro, this is a contributing element to the Town of Boonsboro Historic District.

333 North Main Street is a west-facing, two-and-a-half-story, three-bay, freestanding, brick, American Four Square residential structure. The building, which is set on a triangular lot near the public-right-of-way, either altered to accommodate a commercial function that no longer occupies it or was originally constructed this way. The building, which rests on a stone foundation, is laid in a running bond in an orange brick. The first floor of the northwest corner of the building has been chamfered to accommodate a set of double doors typically found on a commercial storefront. The flanking bays (on the north and west facades) have received shop windows. The entire composition is topped by a projecting box cornice. The hipped roof is covered with artificial shingling and has one chimney at the center. There is a single hipped-roof dormer facing the street. The hipped-roof porch is supported by columns set on brick piers and is almost identical to the one found on its neighbor to the south--331 North Main Street. The residential entrance is located south bay. Windows are double-hung, one-over-one sash with rough-cut stone sills and lintels. They are set singly and in pairs. A two-story open porch on the rear has been altered by the enclosure of the first floor section.



Although none of the historic maps of Boonsboro extends this far north, the construction of the building can be dated approximately to the period between 1910 and 1924 when other similar buildings in Boonsboro were built.

The building is within the Western Maryland Geographic

Organization, the Development Period of Industrial/Urban Dominance,
and falls within the Historic Period Theme of Architecture,
Landscape Architecture, and Community Planning.
