Description of Property and Eligibility Determination: *(Use continuation sheet if necessary and attach map and photo)*

No. 414 N. Main Street is a two-and-one-half-story, three-bay-wide, hip-roofed, American Foursquare, detached, single-family dwelling. The brick house is laid in a stretcher bond; segmentally-arched door and window openings feature limestone/sandstone keystones. The asphalt-shingled roof includes a hip dormer and interior chimney. Windows are 4/1 wood sashes. The single-leaf, half-glass door is flanked with sidelights and transom. The entrance is paired with a triple window. The southwest corner of the house incorporates a projecting polygonal bay/engaged corner tower, with a peaked roof. Northwest of the house is a frame, hip-roofed, single-car garage on rubblestone foundation. This house, built at the intersection of the late-Victorian Queen Anne and the early-twentieth-century American Foursquare, is typical of early-twentieth-century domestic architecture in Boonsboro. This house is a contributing resource to the Town of Boonsboro Historic District.




North Main Street, Boonsboro, MD





414 North Main Street is an east-facing, two-and-a-half-story, three-bay, brick, freestanding, American Four Square residential structure. The building, which is set back from the public-right-of-way on a landscaped lawn, rests on a concrete foundation and is in a forked, red and grey brick with a cream colored mortar. A two-story, octagonal bay with a pyramidal roof is located at the southwest corner of the house. The hipped roof is covered with artificial shingles, and has open, bracketed eaves and one dormer facing the street. The porch roof is supported by battered columns set on brick piers. The entrance door is located in the north bay and is partially obscured by a storm door, but appears to be original. The jack-arched windows have stone keystones and are double-hung, vertical four-over-one sash. They are set in triplets on the first floor and attic. There is a detached garage on the property.

Although none of the historic maps of Boonsboro extends this far north, the construction of the building can be dated approximately to the period between 1910 and 1924 when other similar buildings in Boonsboro were built.

The building is within the Western Maryland Geographic Organization, the Development Period of Industrial/Urban Dominance, and falls within the Historic Period Theme of Architecture, Landscape Architecture, and Community Planning.
