Description of Property and Eligibility Determination: *(Use continuation sheet if necessary and attach map and photo)*

No. 330 North Main Street is a one-and-one-half-story, three-bay-wide, side-gabled, frame and masonry bungalow with an inset front gable. The first floor of the bungalow is faced in cobblestone; the gables have been clad in asbestos shingles. The windows are multipane-over-one wood sashes. There is a triple window in the half-story gable; the first floor has a triple window and a single windows flanking the single-leaf door. There is a cobblestone exterior side chimney. The one-story, three-bay, integral porch has stubby colonettes atop cobblestone piers. Off the southwest corner of the house is a gable-front, frame, early-twentieth-century garage, probably a contemporary of the house. This house, an example of early-twentieth-century domestic architecture in Boonsboro, is a contributing resource to the Town of Boonsboro Historic District.




330 North Main Street is an east-facing, one-and-a-half-story, three-bay, stone and frame, freestanding, rustic bungalow. The building is set back from the public-right-of-way on a landscaped lawn. The first floor of the structure is of stone construction, while the second floor is frame that has been covered with asbestos siding. The open eave, side-gable roof has one massive intersecting gable dormer that is typical of the bungalow style. The house roof extends over the structure to form the roof of the front porch that extends the full length of the house. A large stone chimney flanks the house. The entrance is located in the center bay and is composed of a door topped by a four-light transom. The door is in the craftsman style--it has a large panel above which is a small, rectangular eight-light window. The window on the first floor of the front facade consists of three components: a large fixed pane topped by a smaller pane divided by lead into ten sections (two x five), and flanking double-hung, nine-over-one windows. The dormer and the windows on the side elevations are twelve-over-one lights. All windows have wood sills and lintels.

Although none of the historic maps of Boonsboro extends this far north, the construction of the building can be dated approximately to the period between 1910 and 1924 when other similar buildings in Boonsboro were built.

The building is within the Western Maryland Geographic Organization, the Development Period of Industrial/Urban Dominance,

and falls within the Historic Period Theme of Architecture,
Landscape Architecture, and Community Planning.
