Description of Property and Eligibility Determination: *(Use continuation sheet if necessary and attach map and photo)*

This house is a two-story, two-bay-wide, frame, American Foursquare, detached dwelling on a brick and concrete-stuccoed foundation. The house has been sided in aluminum. There is a two-story projecting polygonal bay on the north half of the facade, and another on the north elevation. The one-story, two-bay porch has a hip roof and Tuscan-derived support columns. The windows are 1/1 wood sashes. The single-leaf door is half glass. There is an interior side chimney on the north side of the house. The hip-roofed house has deep eaves. There is a low-pitched gable-roofed garage west of the house. As an example of the early-twentieth-century preference for the Foursquare as a dwelling type, this house, which dates to the first decade of the twentieth-century, is a contributing resource to the Town of Boonsboro Historic District.


108 North Main Street is an east-facing, two-and-a-half-story, three-bay, frame, freestanding, American Four Square residential structure. The building, which is set directly at the public-right-of-way, rests on a stuccoed foundation and is covered with manufactured siding. The facade has a two-story octagonal bay in the north bay. The hipped roof is covered with artificial shingling and has one chimney. A hipped-roof porch, supported by doric columns, extends across the facade of the house and protects the south-bay entrance and the bay window. The door is a mostly glazed. Windows are double-hung, one-over-one sash. The house has a detached garage.

This structure was built on a site that held a frame dwelling from at least 1877 until 1904. The extant structure first appears on the 1910 Sanborn and is numbered 2 Main Street.

The building is within the Western Maryland Geographic Organization, the Development Period of Industrial/Urban Dominance, and falls within the Historic Period Themes of Government/Law; and Architecture, Landscape Architecture, and Community Planning.
