Description of Property and Eligibility Determination: *(Use continuation sheet if necessary and attach map and photo)*

214 S. Main Street is a two-and-one-half-story, three-bay, detached, single-family dwelling laid in a five-course American bond brick. There are two interior end chimneys and an inset front gable in the side-gabled roof. The two-story gable ell addition has an interior end chimney and smaller one-story board and batten sided (possibly incorporated outbuilding) section with a rubblestone and brick exterior end chimney. The firebox is located on the exterior side of the chimney. The one-story, three-bay porch has turned posts and brackets. The house has 6/6 wood sash windows, with 1/1 wood sash windows on first floor facade. There is a frame, gable-roofed barn with exterior track sliding door located to rear of the house. This mid-to late-nineteenth-century house is a contributing resource to the Town of Boonsboro Historic District.



214 South Main Street is an east-facing, horizontally massed, two-and-a-half-story, brick, freestanding, residential structure. The building, which is set slightly back from the public-right-of-way, rests on a stone foundation. The orange brick, which is was set in a cream color mortar in common bond, has been sandblasted. The cross-gable roof is covered with artificial roll and has two corbelled chimneys. An eastlake porch extends across the facade of the house. Windows throughout the house are double-hung. Those on the first floor are one-over-one sash, while those on the second floor are six-over-six. The attic has a pentoid shape, four-pane casement window. The first and second floor windows have wood sills, soldier coursing for lintels, and shutters. The entrance is a 1940s(?) glazed door topped by a single-light transom. The structure has a two-story, brick rear ell and a one-story vertically sided frame addition on a stone foundation. A bank barn on a stone foundation and a tractor (?) barn are located on the south portion of the property.

Based on the style of the house, as well as other houses in the area with similar architectural features, the building appears to date from the late 19th century.

The building is within the Western Maryland Geographic Organization, the probable Development Period of Industrial/Urban Dominance, and falls within the Historic Period Theme of Architecture, Landscape Architecture, and Community Planning.


