The house has 6/1 wood sash windows and a central single-leaf door. There is a one-story, one-bay gable-roofed porch. This house appears to date to the 1940s and is not contributing to the Boonsboro Historic District (outside of period of significance).



236 South Main Street is an east-facing, horizontally massed, one-and-a-half-story, three-bay, freestanding, residential structure. The building, which is set at the public-right-of-way, rests on a concrete foundation and is covered with manufactured siding. The structure has a side-gable, artificial roll roof with one chimney. A small portico is set in front of the center bay entrance. Windows are double-hung, six-over-one sash. A new deck has been added to the back of the house.

Based on the style and shape of the house, it appears to have been built in the 1940s.

The building is within the Western Maryland Geographic Organization, the Modern Development Period, and falls within the Historic Period Theme of Architecture, Landscape Architecture, and Community Planning.
