112 Potomac Street is a north-facing, two-story, three-bay, frame, freestanding, residential structure. The building, which is set directly at the public-right-of-way and rests on a stuccoed foundation, has been covered with manufactured siding. It has a side-gable, tin roof with one chimney. The west-bay door is obscured by a modern storm door. Fenestration includes double-hung, two-over-two sash windows with rounded panes in the upper sash. The structure has a rear ell.

A building of similar configuration is indicated on the 1877 map of the town. The 1910-1940 Sanborn maps show the structure as 75 Potomac Street and indicate that it never had a porch during that period.


The building is within the Western Maryland Geographic Organization, the probable Development Period of Agricultural-Industrial Transition, and falls within the Historic Period Theme of Architecture, Landscape Architecture, and Community Planning.
