203 Potomac Street is a south-facing, horizontally massed, two-and-a-half-story, three-bay, frame, freestanding, residential structure. The building, which is set directly at the public-right-of-way, rests on a stone foundation and has been covered with manufactured siding. It has a side-gable, tin roof with open eaves, gable returns, and a steeply pitched gabled dormer facing the street. There is a new, exterior brick chimney. An aluminum awning protects the center-bay entrance which is composed of a 1940s, glazed door. The fenestration has all been replaced with double-hung, one-over-one and one-over-two sash. The window in the attic is pentoid in shape. The structure has a two-story rear ell. The sideyard is paved and there is a frame shed in the back yard.

The 1877 map of Boonsboro indicates that this lot was vacant at that time. However, by 1910, according to the Sanborn map, a house had been constructed on this site. The map indicates that the extant structure was altered, perhaps when the manufactured siding was added. In 1910, the house had a bay window on the front facade and a porch that extended across the facade. The 1910-1940 Sanborns show the building as 33 Potomac Street.


The building is within the Western Maryland Geographic Organization, the Development Period of Industrial/Urban Dominance, and falls within the Historic Period Theme of Architecture, Landscape Architecture, and Community Planning.
