15 Potomac Street is a south-facing, horizontally massed, two-and-a-half-story, three-bay, brick, freestanding, residential structure. The building, which is set directly at the public-right-of-way, rests on a stone foundation and is laid in a flemish bond that has been painted. It has a cross-gable, artificial shingle roof with open eaves, gable returns, a dormer facing the street, and two chimneys. The gable ends and the dormer have decorative bargeboards. A hipped-roof porch supported on slender columns resting on brick plinths, wraps around the facade and east elevation. A sunrise motif is located in the porch pediment. A one-story bay window is located under the porch on the east elevation. The entrance is located in the east bay and is obscured by a jalousied storm door. The entry door is crowned by a rectangular, diamond-paned transom. Fenestration includes rectangular, double-hung, one-over-one windows. The structure has a large, rear, two-story ell with a two-story, open porch.

A building at this site is indicated on the 1877 map of the town. The 1897 and 1904 Sanborn maps note the building as 106 West Church and indicate that the wrap-around porch and bay window had not yet been added to the structure. By 1910, however, the porch and bay had been added, as had a small, one-story frame addition to the end of the ell. No other changes are noted on later maps.

The building is within the Western Maryland Geographic Organization, the probable Development Period of Agricultural-Industrial Transition, and falls within the Historic Period Theme


of Architecture, Landscape Architecture, and Community Planning.
