102 Lakin Street is a north-facing, one-and-a-half-story, brick, freestanding, residential structure. The building, which is set on a corner lot on a landscaped lawn, rests on a stuccoed, concrete foundation. The yellow-orange brick is laid in a running bond in a red mortar. The style of the building is reminiscent of english cottages with its steeply pitched roof, exterior chimney and its round-arched windows and entryway.

This building is first noted on the 1940 Sanborn and is numbered 115 Lakin Street.

The building is within the Western Maryland Geographic Organization, the Modern Development Period, and falls within the Historic Period Theme of Architecture, Landscape Architecture, and Community Planning.
