



120 Lakin Street is a north-facing, two-story, three-bay, frame, freestanding, brick, residential structure. The building, which is set on an open lawn, has a hipped roof that is interrupted by a broken pediment of the east bay of the house. This pediment holds a lunette window with a keystone. A flat-roof porch extends across the facade and is supported by slender columns. It protects the east-bay entrance which consists of a door flanked by sidelights and topped by a fanlight.

Although there are no historic maps of this section of Boonsboro, the building probably dates to the 1920s and 1930s when this part of the town was being developed.

The building is within the Western Maryland Geographic Organization, the Modern Development Period, and falls within the Historic Period Theme of Architecture, Landscape Architecture, and Community Planning.
