122 Lakin Street is a north-facing, one-and-a-half-story, frame, freestanding, residential structure. The building rests on a concrete foundation and has been covered with manufactured siding. The cross-gable roof is covered with artificial roll and has wide eaves with triangular brackets. A hipped-roof porch extends across the facade of the building and protects the west-bay entrance. The door is craftsman in style. Fenestration consists of vertical four-over-one double-hung windows set singly and in triplets on the first floor and singly in the attic story.

Although there are no historic maps of this section of Boonsboro to help determine the date of this building, it appears to have been constructed in the 1910s or 1920s.

The building is within the Western Maryland Geographic Organization, the probable Development Period of Industrial/Urban Dominance, and falls within the Historic Period Theme of Architecture, Landscape Architecture, and Community Planning.
