ADDRESS: Northwest corner of Lakin and Center Streets, Boonsboro, MD

BUILDING DATE: 19th century, pre-1897

This is a one-story, brick, freestanding, hipped roof structure set back from Lakin Street that serves as a storage building for the Bast Furniture store on North Main Street. The structure has three, double-hung, six-over-six windows facing Lakin Street and mature trees and a board and batten storehouse in the yard. The structure is shown on the 1897 Sanborn as being a structure on a separate lot directly behind the property numbered 348 Main Street (two structures south of Bast Furniture). This structure is numbered 105 Lakin on the 1924 Sanborn.

The building is within the Western Maryland Geographic Organization, and falls within the Historic Period Theme of Architecture, Landscape Architecture, and Community Planning.
