DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This house apparently of log construction is a two story, six bay building covered with asbestos shingles. Several six over six pane sashes remain in the windows. Windows and doors are placed at random in the walls. Two front doors are sheltered by a Victorian entrance porch with turned posts. Near the center of the roof is a small wooden belfry. Behind the house is a stone springhouse with an exterior stone and brick chimney.


