DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This two story, five bay brick L-shaped farmhouse would appear to date from the third quarter of the 19th century. It has common bond brickwork at all elevations with openings having wide wooden lintels. Six over six pane window sashes are used. The main entrance is located in the center bay of the front elevation. A two story, three bay brick wing with frame additions extends to the rear.


