DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The house on this farm is a two story, five bay L-shaped brick structure with common bond at all elevations. Centered in the front elevation is a cross gable with a pair of arched topped windows. The central entrance has a four panel door with sidelights on either side below a broad seven light transom. A complete set of outbuildings is present including a brick bake house, a brick spring house, a log smoke house and a secondary dwelling known as a "slave house" of frame construction with board and batten siding. A barn and agricultural outbuildings are also present. Near the complex are ruins of a log house which is supposed to predate the other buildings.




