DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This farmhouse is a two story, three bay brick structure resting on low fieldstone foundations which project slightly beyond the wall surface of the house. A one story, three bay brick wing is attached to the end wall. The entire house has been painted white with Flemish bond at the front elevation and common bonding at the side and rear walls. Windows have six over six pane sashes. The house would appear to date from the second quarter of the 19th century. A frame bank barn is also part of the complex. Near the house is a cemetery with people from several prominent Pleasant Valley families: Crampton, Thomas, Claggett, Boteler, Young and Knode. The oldest grave belongs to one Posthumous Claggett who was born in 1738 and died in 1822.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

This brick farmhouse probably dating from the second quarter of the 19th century is a typical architectural example of the period. The cemetery on the property is important because it has members of locally prominent families.

The property includes parts of the land grants "Park Hall," "Boteler's Ramble," "Strife" and "Timber and Stone."


