DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This sided log house is a two and one half story, three bay structure which would appear to date from Ca. 1800. It is on raised stone foundations which become a full story in height at the front elevation. Windows have wide massive frames with nine over six pane sashes at the main and upper story levels. Entrances in the central bays have six raised panels. The siding and main section shutters are modern. Near the house are two stone outbuildings, one a spring house and secondary dwelling, the other a spring house and outkitchen. They appear to be newer than the main house.

Also part of the complex is a large frame bank barn with a roof having an unusually steep pitch and a wagon shed with an unusual roofing system. Various other sheds and outbuildings are also present.


