DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This two story, three bay log house is completely sheathed with composition siding. A one story, two bay kitchen wing extends to the rear and has a large exterior stone chimney. The main section windows have six over six pane sashes. The center front door has a three light transom and the entrance lintel is at a higher level than those of the windows, a feature often associated with early log construction.
