DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This two part brick farmhouse is two stories high and seven bays long. The three west bays of the south or front elevation and the four eastern bays at the first story level display Flemish bond brick work while other areas show common bonding. A vertical seam in the masonry divides the two sections at the second story level. First story windows have nine over six pane sashes while those at the second story have six over six sashes. The older part of the house would appear to date from the second quarter of the 19th century. Also present is a frame bank barn and various outbuildings.


