DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This two story, three bay stone farmhouse is an L-shaped structure built in two parts. The ell extension to the rear would appear to be an addition. Large flat pieces of stone form the lintels for most doors and windows of the front section. The stone is the brownish grandular rock found in Pleasant Valley. The main entrance is located in the center bay of the front elevation.


