The frame house is a two-story frame structure constructed in a rectangular plan. It is a four-bay by two-bay structure covered in modern aluminum siding. The main facade is symmetrically arranged with two entrances in the two central bays of the main story. Four-over-four sash windows are located in the outer bays of the first story and the four bays of the second story. Victorian-style ornamentation includes an ornamental bracket cornice and a full-length, one-story porch with turned posts. The structure appears to date from the late 19th century.

The property is located on the north side of Sandy Hook Road, approximately .13 mile east of Clark Road, in Sandy Hook. The structure is built on a slight slope away from the road and has a full-story foundation on the main facade. The main facade faces south.

The two-story structure is constructed of frame covered in a modern aluminum siding on a fieldstone foundation. The main facade is symmetrically arranged with entrances in the two central bays. Two-over-two sash windows are located in the outer bays of the first story and the three bays of the second story. The full-length, one-story front porch is elevated above the foundation level by brick plinths. A wood stair with the slat railing leads up from ground level to the porch. One section of the porch sits slightly higher than the other section. The porch roof is supported by turn posts. The front cornice includes a bracket frieze with smaller bracket dentils. The cornice turns the corner one bracket length. The gable ends contain two two-over-two sash windows on each story. The roof is covered in sheet metal. It has interior-end brick chimneys with corbelled caps.






