The frame house is a two-story frame structure constructed in a rectangular plan. It is four bays by two bays constructed on a fieldstone foundation. The exterior is covered in weatherboard siding. The main facade is asymmetrically arranged with entrances in the outer bays and only three windows on the second story. It has a full-length, one-story porch with turned posts and stick railing. The structure appears to date from the mid-19th century.

The property is located on the north side of Sandy Hook Road, approximately .1 mile east of Clark Road, in Sandy Hook. The house is on a gently sloping site with a high foundation in the front. The main facade faces south.

The two story structure is constructed of frame on a fieldstone foundation. The exterior is covered in an uneven weatherboard siding. The main facade is asymmetrically arranged. On the first story, entrances are in the outer bays and six-over-one sash windows are in the central bays. The entrances have a plain trim with a three-pane transom. The second story has three six-over-one windows with the westernmost bay left unfenestrated. The gable ends have six-over-one windows in both bays of six stories. The windows have plain trim painted a dark color. The gable roof has a boxed cornice. The roof is covered in sheet metal. There is a square brick chimney stack with corbelled cap rising from the center of the structure.






WA-III-032, Sandy Hook Survey District




