The frame house is a two-story frame structure constructed in a rectangular plan. It is three-bays by one-bay and its exterior appearance shows a number of modern improvements. It has a full-length, one-story front porch of modern construction. The windows in the outer bays of the first story are modern single-pane windows. Exterior covering is aluminum siding. The structure does retain a bracket cornice of an earlier period's ornamentation. The structure appears to date from the late 19th century.

The property is located on the north side of Sandy Hook Road, approximately .02 mile east of Clark Road, in Sandy Hook. The structure sits slightly back from the road. The main facade faces south.

The two-story structure is constructed of frame and covered in a modern aluminum siding. The main facade is symmetrically arranged with a central entrance and full-length, one-story porch. The porch is constructed of all modern materials. Also, the door and first-story windows are modern. The second story and each story on the gable end have one-over-one sash windows. The structure does retain a late 19th century bracket cornice on the main facade. The roof is covered in asphalt shingles.






WA-III-032, Sandy Hook Survey District


