Prepare both a summary paragraph and a general description of the resource and its various elements as it exists today.

The frame house is a two-story frame structure constructed in a rectangular plan. It is three-bays by one-bay and is covered in German siding. The structure has a central entrance with two-over-two sash windows in the outer bays of the first story. The second story also has a central entrance with two-over-two sash windows. The porch on the structure presently is a one-story porch supported by square posts. This porch does not appear to be original. The structure appears to date from the late 19th century.

The property is located on the north side of Sandy Hook Road, approximately .19 mile west of Clark Road, in Sandy Hook. The house sits slightly back from the road and close to the two-story brick house on the east. It apparently was an accessory building to the brick house. The main facade faces south.

The two-story structure is constructed of frame covered in German siding. The structure sits on a level site and does not have a foundation story. The main facade is symmetrically arranged with a central entrance on both the first and second stories and two-over-two sash windows in the outer bays on both stories. Presently the structure has a one-story, full-length front porch with a shed roof supported by square posts. The gable ends of the structure are unfenestrated. The east gable end has an exterior-end brick chimney and the west gable end has a concrete block chimney on a stone base. The roof has a boxed cornice and is covered in asphalt siding.






