This property is located on the east side of Main Street in Rohrsersville. The house is a two story, four bay log building covered with asbestos shingle siding. A two story L extends to the rear. Windows have been replaced with modern single pane sash, sheltered by vinyl awnings. The off-center entrance is located in the second bay from the south end of the house. A two bay hipped roof entrance porch supported by square posts is centrally placed at the front of the house. Brick chimneys are located inside the gable ends. There is a semi-attached gable fronted garage and carport. Although altered, this log house--with a Germanic facade arrangement with an off center front door and four bay front--is representative of the heritage of the village. The attribution of log construction is based on the thickness of the walls and the estimate of construction date is based on the log construction, chimney size and overall form and plan. According to the 1877 Atlas Map for Washington County, this property was part of the "Mullendore Estate."
