This two story three bay frame house rests on fieldstone foundations. It is covered with asbestos shingle siding and includes a frame L extension to the rear. Windows have two over two light sash within architraves with molded flat tops with small decorative brackets. The windows also have pairs of louvered shutters. The main entrance is located in the center bay of the front elevation and includes a two light transom. Across the front is a one story porch supported by large square posts. Brick chimneys are located inside each gable end. The roofing material is standing seam sheet metal. The date attribution is based on the light frame construction, windows and their trim and the overall form of the house. Further, it is not shown on the 1877 Atlas Map of Rohrerstown. This is an example of a modest turn of the century house in Rohrerstown.
