Approximate date Ca. 1900

Located on the east side of Main Street is this brick two story, three bay house resting on fieldstone foundations. Bricks are laid in common bond and are painted dark red. Segmental arches of brick form the tops of the openings. Windows have two over two pane sash. Wooden infill within the segmental arches is trimmed with cut out floral designs. The front entrance is located in the center bay of the front elevation and includes a two light transom. Across the front is a porch supported by round Tuscan Doric columns. Brick chimneys are located inside the gable ends. An enclosed shed roofed porch is located at the rear of the house. The roof is covered with pressed tin shingles. A frame shed at the rear of the house has been covered with aluminum siding. It is considered to be a contributing building since it rests on stone foundations. The ca. 1900 construction date is based on the segmentally arched windows, porch, overall form and the fact that it does not appear on the 1877 Atlas map.
