This two part house on the west side of Main Street consists of two adjoining three bay log sections joined end to end. Each section is two stories with a window, door, window configuration. A shed extension is attached at the rear. The entire building has been covered with vinyl siding, and the front is unified by a one story Colonial Revival style porch extending its entire length. Most windows have been replaced with modern single pane sash. Some windows at the second story of the north section retain six over six sash. The two entrances each include a narrow transom. According to the 1877 Atlas Map for Rohrersville, the north section was the residence and the south section contained a store. This information was also affirmed by a local resident. The atlas indicates that the property belonged to J.V. Rohrer. At the rear is a metal covered frame stable. Two contributing buildings.
