This American Foursquare style house is among the more recent historic buildings in Rohrerstown. It is located on the west side of Main Street. It has a two-bay-wide facade and the characteristic square shape, hipped roof, dormer and across the front porch. Upper sash have vertical panes with single panes in the lower sash. Front windows are doubled or tripled. The entrance includes a transom and sidelights. The brickwork is done in Flemish bond with recessed joints. Across the front of the property is a poured concrete retaining wall and a set of steps leading to the front porch. Behind the house is a frame shed and a stable. Three contributing buildings.
