This two story, four bay brick cased log house is located on the west side of Main Street, between it and "Pig Alley" in the village of Rohrersville. Walls are finished in all stretcher bond brick work, which suggests that the bricks are actually a veneer over a log substructure. Above the openings are wide wooden lintels, which are characteristic of mid- 19th century construction in Washington County. First floor windows have nine over six light sash, while six over six light sash are used at the second floor level. At the second story, there only three windows, there being none above the more northerly of the two doors. The two front doors each have six panels beneath four light transoms. A shed roofed entrance porch appears to be a replacement of the original one. Brick chimneys are located inside the gable ends. The date attribution is based on the 9/6 and 6/6 windows, wide wooden lintels, doors and transoms. According to the 1877 Atlas map, this property was owned by R. McCoy at the time. The McCoy's owned and operated a marble works across the street from this property. This house reflects the traditional vernacular architecture of Rohrersville.
