Located on the northwest corner of Main Street and Rohrersville Road in the village of Rohrersville is this late 19th century two story frame L shaped house. It is covered with aluminum siding. Character defining features include doubled windows at the front elevation and a two story semi-hexagonal projecting bay attached to the south gable end. A three bay front porch is supported by turned posts with decorative cutwork brackets. The L to the rear has a two story inset porch. The facade is three bays wide with a central entrance. Windows have single pane sash. The roof is of standing seam sheet metal and brick chimneys with corbeled tops are located inside the gable ends of the front section. The date attribution is based on the light frame construction, double windows and projecting bay, and the fact that the property does not appear on the 1877 Atlas map. 1 contributing building.
