Located on the east side of Main Street in Rohrerstown is this house, at the south edge of the village. It is a two story, three bay frame building, covered with asbestos shingle siding. It rests on high stone foundations. A rear porch is enclosed at the back of the house. Windows have two over two sash with architraves with flat molded tops. The entrance is located in the center bay of the front elevation and includes a two light transom. Across the front is a porch supported by round columns. Brick chimneys are located inside the gable ends. A non-contributing frame garage is located to the south of the house. This turn of the century frame house is indicative of the buildings at the southern edge of Rohrerstown, away from the older center of the village. Date attribution is based on light frame construction, windows and trim. 1 contributing building.
