Approximate date Ca.1890-1900

Located on the east side of Main Street at the south edge of the village of Rohrersville is this two story, three bay brick house with a semi-hexagonal projecting bay and a central cross gable. It is distinguished by an all stretcher brick front, and common bond side and rear walls and segmental arches of upright bricks over the openings. Front windows are doubled or tripled with single pane sash. Others have two over two light sash, including those in the projecting bay. In the cross gable is a pointed window with two over two light sash. The main entrance in the central bay of the front elevation. Across the front is a Colonial Revival porch with round columns on brick piers. The cross gable, projecting bay, stretcher bond front and porch are all indicative of 1890-1900s construction. This time period is represented by several houses at the south edge of Rohrersville. The older portion of the village is clustered down the hill close to the mill site and marble works. Also on the property is a frame garage covered with German siding and a tin shingle roof. 2 contributing buildings.
