Based on the information provided by the County, the house does not appear to meet the criteria for individual listing nor is it located in an historic district. The house is a mid- to late 19th century frame farmhouse with a number of later additions and alterations. It is not a particularly good example of a common house type for Washington County. The community of Dargan, in which the house is located, did not exist until the latter part of the 19th century and apparently never flourished.
