DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This farm includes a house built by Peter Mong in 1831. It is a two story, five bay brick structure with a Flemish bond facade. An arch topped datestone is inscribed with the initials P*M 1831. The entrance with an eight panel door is located in the center bay of the front elevation. Brick parapets finish the gable end walls. Behind the house is a brick out kitchen with a datestone inscribed P*M 1832. In front of the house is a large spring fed pond with a stone spring house which also has a datestone, this one initialed P*M and inscribed with the year 1845. The present springhouse encloses an older, smaller stone structure of unknown age. Also present is a barn.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

This complex, in excellent condition, provides a complete record of building on this farmstead during the second quarter of the 19th century by Peter Mong, a man of Pennsylvania German origin. Each of these dated buildings is representative of regional vernacular architecture. The Mong family is said to have owned the property until the Civil War period.
